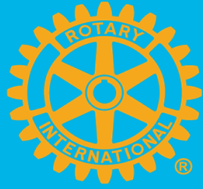

The Arc continues to be a grassroots organization, with more than 730 chapters across the U.S. Thank you both for your dedication to serving our comminutes!



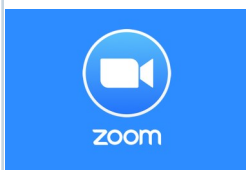
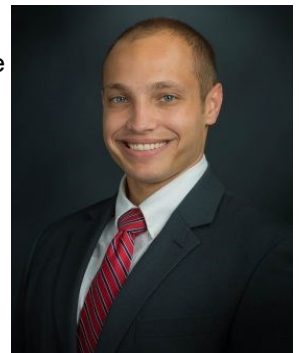
September 2nd: Program



First half: Scott Grant (Historian) - A little history on Bob Hayes (From Jacksonville and won a gold medal in 64 in Tokyo) Scott was born in Scotland and a graduate of Cornell University and the Rutgers School of Law. His first real job was at EF Hutton & Co. They are remembered for a very popular commercial about how when EF Hutton talks, people listen. Before moving to Ponte Vedra 14 years ago, he ran a brokerage division for a large credit union in New Jersey. He and his lovely wife Sharon fell in love with Ponte Vedra while on vacation here. After moving, he founded Standfast Asset Management. This gave him the opportunity to invest money for people who had placed their trust in him in the manner that he thought was most prudent. ****Robert Lee "Bullet Bob" Hayes** was an Olympic gold medalist sprinter who then became an American football wide receiver in the National Football League for the Dallas Cowboys. Bob Hayes is the only athlete to win both an Olympic gold medal and a Super Bowl ring.

Second half: Perry Russell is an attorney and Army National Guard veteran who has re-directed his legal and operational skills into the pension arena.

He is working towards becoming an Enrolled Actuary while focusing on the administration of defined benefit and cash balance plans for small employers. Perry joined the Army National Guard right out of high school, achieved the rank of Sergeant at age 19 and served in Afghanistan as a squad leader tasked with mission security. He is a graduate of the University of South Carolina and the Florida Coastal School of Law. He is a member of the Rotaract Club of Jacksonville's Beaches and active in its international service committee.
