He shared a truly phenomenal story about Bob Hayes a pigeon-toed sprinter who broke world records,



won two gold medals in the 1964 Tokyo Olympics and then became a feared pass receiver for 11 seasons in the National Football League. After track and football, Hayes worked in real estate with a company owned by Roger Staubach, a Cowboys teammate, and he was involved in many businesses. In 1994, he finished his last six credits for his degree from Florida A&M.
