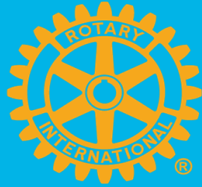

A US national, Erin Smith earned a BS in MIS from George Mason University; a MS in Innovation and Technology from The University of Virginia; and Graduate Certificates in Organizational Development and Change Management from Georgetown University and Social Impact & Strategy from University of Pennsylvania.

Ms. Smith is the current Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Ocean Sole, a US and Kenyan based 501c3. Ocean Sole cleans beaches and transforms the Earth's flip-flop debris into

art. Ocean Sole Africa is an impact business that creates employment for Kenyans and works with some of the most underprivileged coastal communities in Kenya. The company serves a global market and is often regarded as a success story of how to run a social enterprise with empirical impact. Ocean Sole recycles 1 ton of flip flops a week, employs over 100 artisans, donates over 50% of revenue to conservation and education programs and supports over 1200 people in Ocean Sole's supply chain. Recently Ocean Sole Africa had a video titled, "A Flip-flop Artist" go viral and it was viewed by over 120 million people, which has brought Ocean Sole Africa to the forefront in leadership of ocean trash solution businesses.

Prior to her full-time dedication to saving the Ocean, Erin has an impressive career in small to global enterprises in the high-tech, telecommunications and financial services industries having worked in the US, UK, Europe, Asia, Middle East and Africa. She often speaks at industry conferences, universities, radio broadcasts and even has appeared on CNN, BBC, the Oprah Winfrey show and countless other news /industry TV shows and podcasts during her career in ocean conservation and high tech.
