November 4th Program:



MaliVai (Mal) Washington began playing tennis in Michigan at the age of 5 after being introduced to the sport by his father. He won his first title at 8. He later attended the University of Michigan where he became a two time all American and finished his sophomore year ranked as the NCAA #1 tennis player in the nation. In 1996 he reached the Wimbledon Championships final, becoming the first African American man to reach a grand slam singles final since tennis great Arthur Ashe won Wimbledon in 1975. The two remain the only African American men to achieve this feat. In 1994 he created the MaliVai Washington Youth

Foundation to introduce tennis to young people who otherwise wouldn't have the opportunity. In 1997 the Foundation expanded and soon would include after school homework assistance and life skills programs. The Foundation strives to get youth to focus more on education, positive behavior and life skills while becoming productive members of their community. In 2008 the Foundation achieved its most ambitious goal at the time and built the MaliVai Washington Youth Center in Jacksonville to include an academic building and tennis courts to serve the youth and surrounding community. In 2020, after completion of a \$5M capital campaign, the Foundation opened a brand new state of the art "Club 904 Teen Center" to serve Jacksonville's youth for decades to come. Mal has been a real estate investor for over 25 years and in 2015 he founded Diamond Life Real Estate, Inc., a real estate investment company based in Jacksonville Beach, Florida.

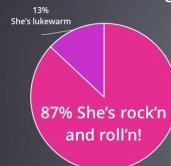

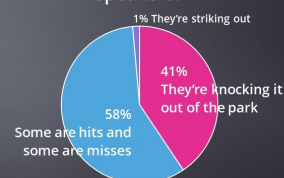

How are you enjoying our speakers?

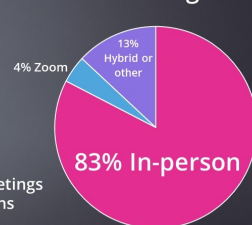


Member Survey Results

the Club's communication?



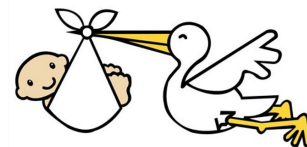
