RLI provides quality education in Rotary knowledge and leadership skills to Rotarians interested in developing their Rotary participation and to those identified by Rotary Clubs as having a potential in club leadership. Classes are generally one hour, but a few are 90 minutes and the content is divided in to three parts: Part 1-The Rotarian (5 sessions), Part 2- The Rotary Club (6 sessions), and Part 3- The Rotary Journey (5 sessions).
