Oceanside Rotary Weekly Meetings

We will start the year continuing to have our hybrid meetings at Jax Golf until further notice. For all live meetings going forward, we do want to make sure we are following current CDC Guidelines for gatherings:

Maintain as much distance as possible between yourself and other individuals, and use masks if they do not interfere with your activity. If you need to be indoors, open windows to increase airflow throughout the space. Use social distancing and limit physical contact.
