Speaker for Monday July 15, 2019 - Ryan Keur Daytona Tortugas



Ryan Keur is the Team President for the Daytona Tortugas. He grew up in New Jersey and attended Elon University in North Carolina. Prior to moving to Daytona Beach, Keur spent the previous six years in Raleigh, North Carolina. All six of those years were spent with the Burlington Royals where Keur was named the General Manager in September 2013. At the time, this made him the youngest General Manager in Baseball. Keur was named the Appalachian League Executive of the Year for each of his three seasons as General Manager in 2014, 2015 and 2016. During Keur's first season in Daytona Beach, the Tortugas saw a 21% attendance increase and he was named the Executive of the Year for all of minor league baseball according to the top two publications- Baseball America and Ballpark Digest. Keur serves locally as an active Board Member for both One Voice for Volusia and Team Volusia. During this past year, the Tortugas have forged a strong partnership with the Volusia County Schools instituting many new programs and initiatives.

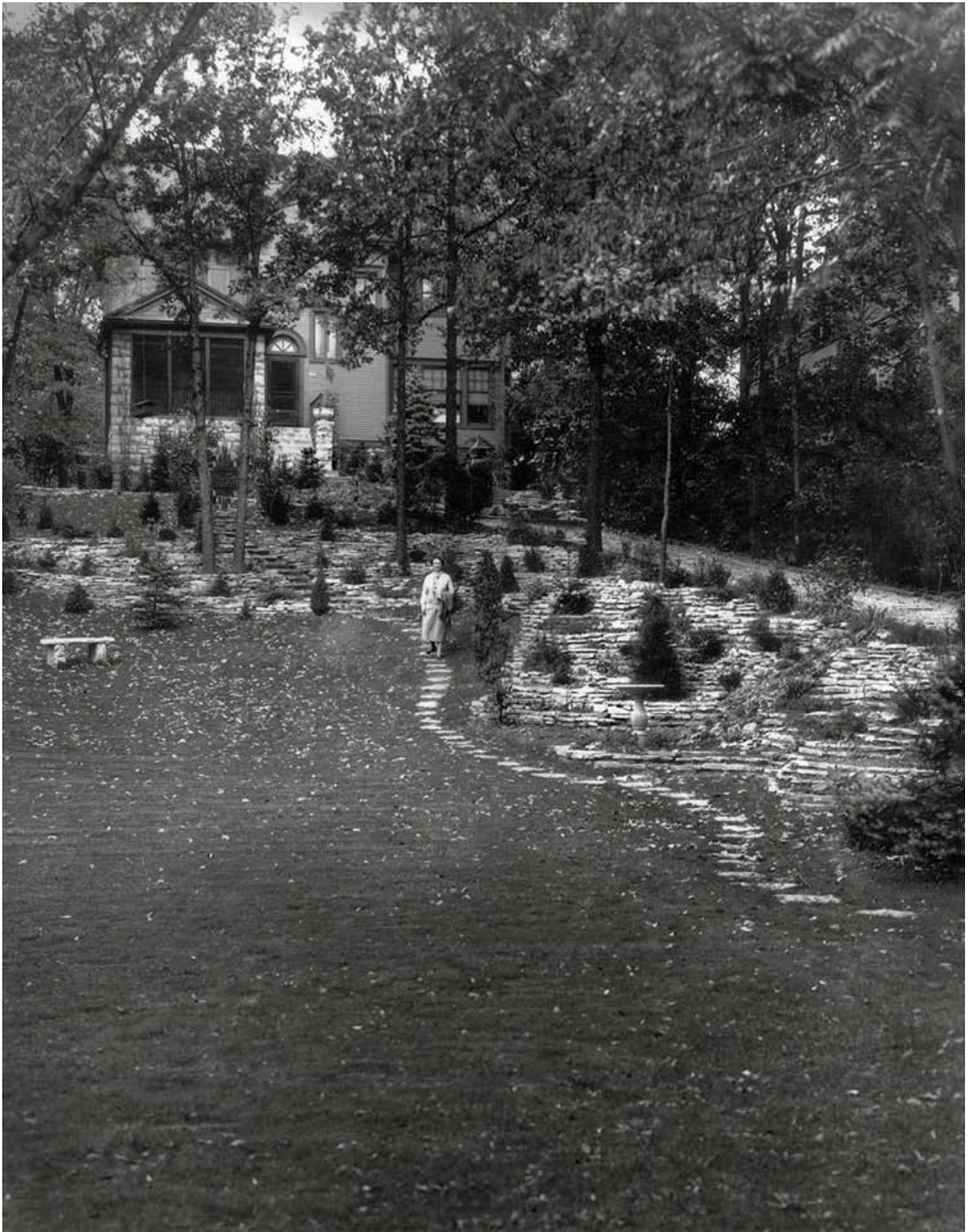

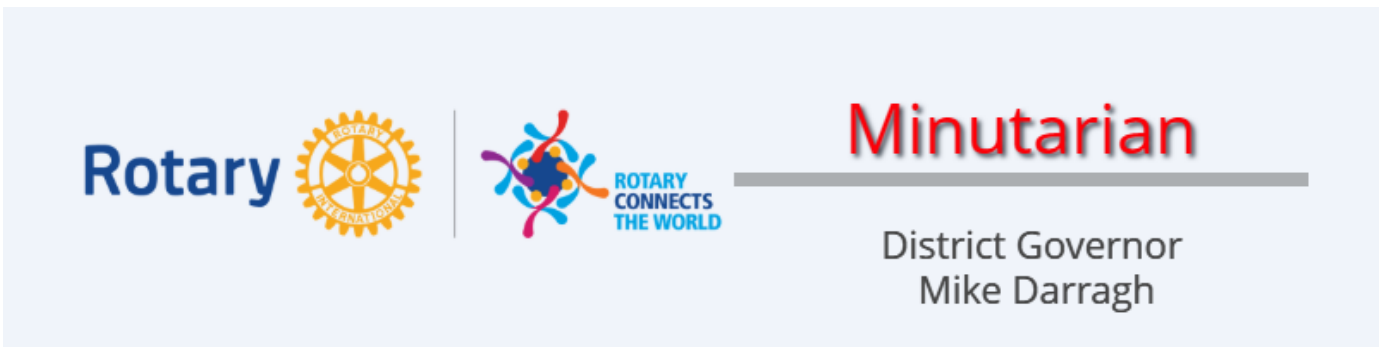


Congratulations Gator Bert!

4. ADAPT for the future.

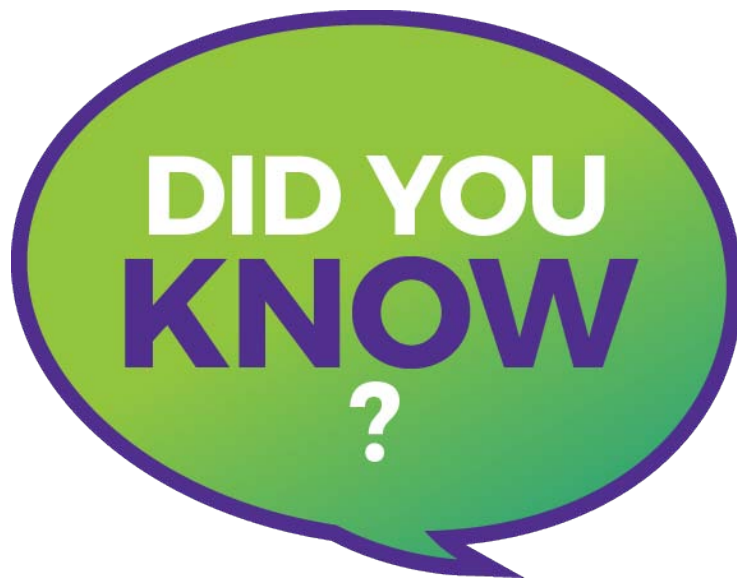
