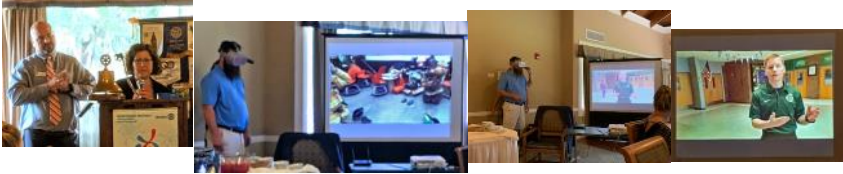

Many! 96% of the children graduate high school on time, and 92% enter a 2 year or 4 year college (plus 68% complete college)!
