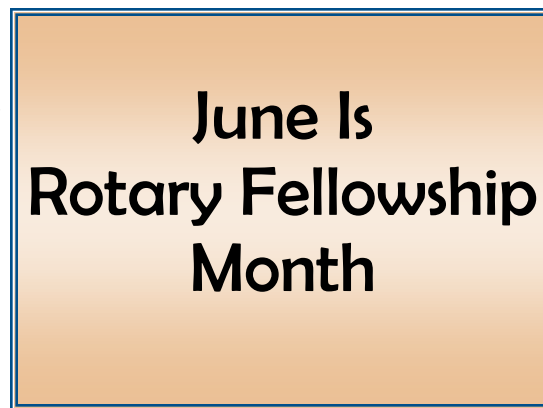

The new Palm Coast City Manager Matthew Morton was our speaker last week.

A self proclaimed "glass half full" person he gave us his vision of the future of Palm Coast. Inspired by the movie "It's A Wonderful Life" as a boy, Morton went into a career of city planner and worked his way up to City Administrator in two cities in the state of Washington.

After Jim Landon's departure from the city, Morton was selected by the City Council to be Palm Coast's City Manager. He came to Palm Coast from Duval, Washington where he was serving as City Administrator.

Morton said he wants to work with the other cities of Flagler County to improve services while keeping costs down. "Meeting with other cities and determining how do we get stronger together and increase levels of service," he said.

"I believe our job as government officials is to remove the obstacles we create and get out of the way," Morton said.

Fantasy Lights: December is six months away but co-chairs of the club's biggest fundraiser- Bill Butler and Mike Kuypers-know it is not too early to start planning. Butler said they have 49 displays so far and they are shooting for 50 this year. Regular

meetings will begin after the installation dinner and work on the event will begin. Last year the club raised \$29,000 at the event. Those funds go back into many programs in the community sponsored by the Rotary Club of Flagler County.
