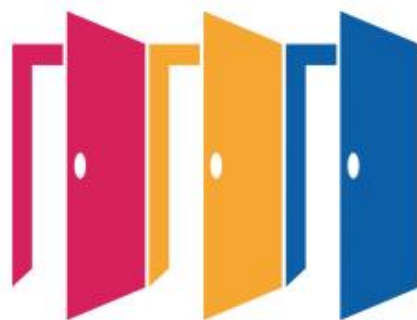

## Last Week's Meeting:

We had a Wonderful Zoom Meeting! We heard from two of our very own rock stars, Joe Rizzo and Christy Butler and their colleague, Doug Glasco regarding career coaching. The Flagler County Education Foundation in partnership with the United Way implemented a program in November 2019 for career coaching for students in 9th-12th grade. This program is designed to put students in touch with mentors or coaches to help guide them with career choices. The students have 3 pathways they can follow to utilize the career coaching. The first is if the student is looking at a very specialized career path such as being a judge. The student would have to meet certain requirements but once met they would be put in touch with a mentor in that field. The second would be if the student was looking at a larger set of careers such as working in health care. This would require a smaller group and a little less specialized. The third pathway is for students that do not have any specific career path.

Christy Butler informed us that there is training for the mentor/coach and is also provided a career coach tool kit. This tool kit gives you ideas on how to connect and engage with your student including a film and also a roadmap. This roadmap provides a guide from the introduction, to the curriculum, and continues throughout your 4 year coaching experience. You will receive one on one training to let you know what to expect and how to use the tool kit.

What an incredible opportunity this program provides for not only the student but also the coach! You will be helping a student determine his or her future all the while building a relationship that could last well after they graduate! Thank you Flagler County Education Foundation for providing such an incredible program to Flagler County Students!

Mr. Neu is on Florida Regional Vice President and on the Board of Directors of the Society of Former Special Agents of the FBI. He is a life member of the International Association of Chiefs of Police and an associate member of the Criminal Justice Section of the American Bar Association. He is also a member of the Springfield Gardens Masonic Lodge #1057 in New York, Houston Scottish Rite and Arabia Shrine Temple, Houston, Texas. In 1981 Mr. Neu joined the Oyster Creek Rotary Club, Missouri City, Texas and later was a founding member of the Sugar Creek Rotary Club, Sugarland, Texas. He became a Paul Harris Fellow in 1989. After retiring and moving to Palm Coast, Florida Mr. Neu joined the Rotary Club of Flagler County in 2006 in which he has held various positions. His son, Kenneth Scott Neu graduated from Hofstra University in New York and operates his own accounting firm in Garden City, New York. Mr. Neu and his wife Diane, a retired FBI Analyst, recently celebrated their 30<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary.

## GET TO KNOW YOUR FELLOW ROTARIAN

Mr. Neu was born in New York City, New York. He attended Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Troy, New York, where he received Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Electrical Engineering. Prior to joining the FBI he was a Design Engineer for Raytheon Corporation, Space and Information Systems Division, Sudbury, Massachusetts.

He entered on duty as a Special Agent with the FBI in August, 1969, and has served in the Milwaukee, New York, Tampa, Philadelphia and Houston Field Offices as well as an assignment at the FBI Laboratory in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Neu was promoted to Supervisor in January, 1981, while assigned to the Houston Division. He was assigned to the Criminal Investigative Division (CID), Violent Crimes and Major Offenders Section (VCMOS) at FBI Headquarters (FBIHQ) in March 1990. During this assignment he played an integral role in the formulation of the FBI's "Safe Streets" Violent Crimes Initiative. In January, 1993, he was assigned to the Inspection Division, FBIHQ and upon completion of that tour of duty in October 1993, was assigned to the Organizational Intelligence Unit, Intelligence Section, CID at FBIHQ. He was promoted to Unit Chief of the Safe Streets and Gang Unit, VCMOS, CID, at FBIHQ in August 1995. As Acting Section Chief in 1996 he was directly involved in the formation within the VCMOS of the Office of Crimes Against Children and Office of Indian Country Investigations. In January 1999, Mr. Neu was promoted to Assistant Chief, VCMOS, CID at FBIHQ. While in this position he was responsible for the reorganization of the Violent Crimes and Major Offenders Program which included the establishment of the FBI's Crimes Against Children investigative program.

Mr. Neu retired from the FBI in November 2002, and then worked for The Gavin Group under a contract with the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops auditing dioceses within the United States for compliance with the Child Protection Charter adopted by the Conference. Continued on Page 2.....
