Jan 12: Jennifer Mitchell St. Johns Water Management

Jennifer Mitchell, Public Communications Coordinator for St. Johns Water Management was our guest speaker. She gave an interesting presentation on how we all influence our water quality. She also emphasized how storm water flows downhill, even in Florida, which means all of our water usage is connected in some way.

Nutrients getting to the St. Johns continues to create algae blooms and weakens the overall health of the river ecosystem. Over watering your lawn and shrubs can actually cause fungus and disease, especially in the winter. Their water wise web site has useful information on ways to better conserve our water resources. We are making headway as the water consumption per person per day has fallen from as high as 150 as person to around 65 gallons a day currently. She also answered all our water related questions and received our Polio Vaccination Inoculation Certificate.

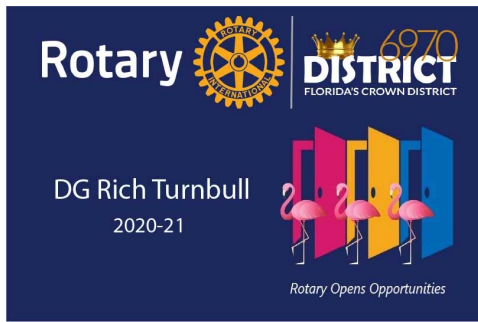
