Sean spent several years as a Sergeant with the New York Police Department, New York City, where he received several citations for meritorious and excellent police duty. During his tenure with the NYPD, Mr. Mulholland worked with the Tactical Patrol Force; Street Crime Unit and was a Confidential Investigator to the First Deputy Police Commissioner.

Sean is a certified legal investigator, fraud examiner and protection professional. He is also an adjunct professor at several local universities and the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC), Brunswick, GA. He founded Mulholland Investigation and Forensics in 1997.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR FELLOWSHIP

Most Rotarians are successful professional and business executives because they hear opportunities knock and take advantage of them.
