Update to Club Bylaws

Tuesday, October 5, 2021

The Board of Directors has made a motion to update Article 12, Section 4 of our Bylaws which states: A thorough review of all financial transactions by an external auditor or CPA shall be made at least once each year.

New language reads: A monthly review of the operations financial account and a quarterly review of the charities financial account shall be made by a qualified financial entity or person certified as a CPA, CMA or CIA.

In accordance with Article 16 Amendments, the notice of change is posted to the website at least 7 days before the club meeting at which a vote will be taken on October 15 2021, requiring a ? vote of all members present.

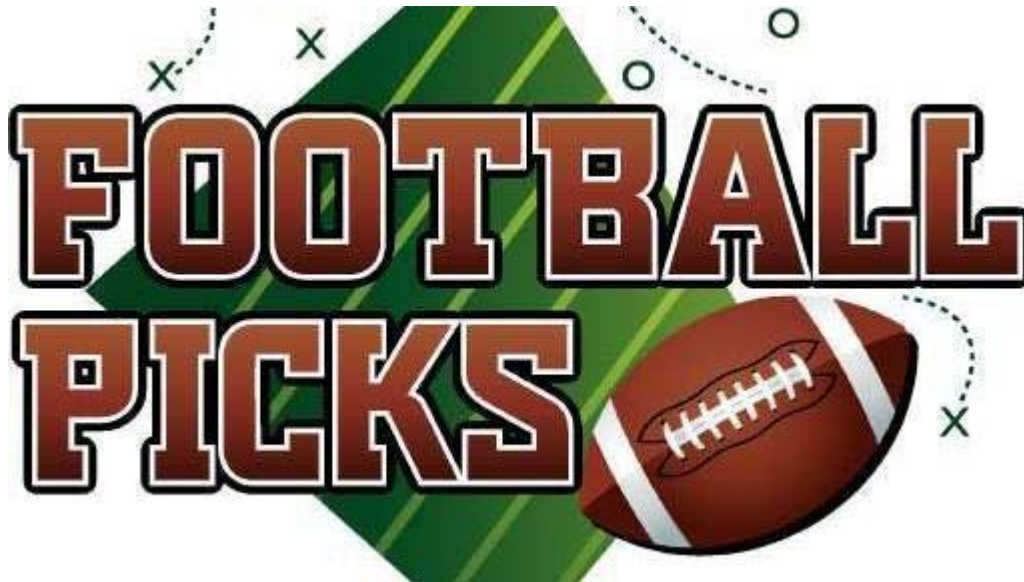
