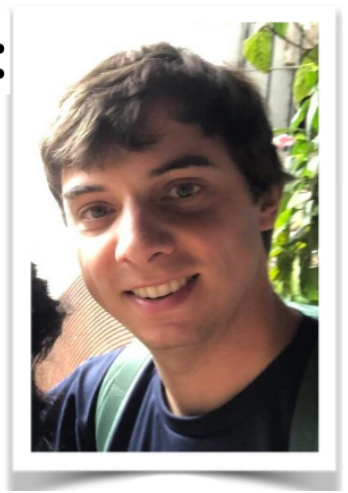
# Speaker of the Week:
