Sarah Dew-Reeves, Ph.D.  
"Stress and Coping for Families in 2020"



Dr. Sarah Dew-Reeves is a native Floridian who grew up in St. Augustine, Florida. She attended the University of Florida for college and Vanderbilt University for her doctoral training.

Dr. Dew-Reeves completed her pre-doctoral internship at Boston Children's Hospital and her post-doctoral fellowship at Children's National Medical Center (CNMC). She worked as a staff psychologist at CNMC for over 4 years then held a faculty position at University of Florida Health - Jacksonville for over 2 years. In 2016, she and her best friend/long-time colleague, Dr. Lisa Bailey, opened their own private practice, Nautilus Behavioral Health in Mandarin.
