Brent deMerville started training in Bujinkan Ninpo Taijitsu under Stephen K. Hayes in 1984 and currently holds a Fifth Degree Black belt in the art with a Shidoshi level instructor's license. That art is often referred to by its popular name, Ninjutsu. This year, he published a book, *The Nine Principles of the Shadow Warrior*, which takes lessons learned from physical movements within his martial art and filters them through lessons learned in organizational development to provide a guidebook toward a more effective personal and professional life.

Brent holds three Master's degrees: Library and Information Science; Clinical Psychology; and Organizational Development. He also has a Ph.D. in Human and Organizational Systems. He was certified in Neurolinguistic Programming by one of its creators,
