Yes, our Meeting is still on...

It will be online via ZOOM and here is how this works!

What is ZOOM you ask? [ZOOM.com](https://zoom.com) is a web-based video conferencing tool with a local, desktop client and a mobile app that allows users to meet online.

You do not have to have a Zoom account to attend a Zoom meeting or interview. You will be prompted to download the software, once you have clicked on the link that you have been provided. You may also wish to create an account, but that is not required to participate in a Zoom meeting.

So here are the steps to join the meeting:

Step 1:

Click on this link: <https://zoom.us/j/947528456>

Step 2:

Simply follow the prompts to download the correct Zoom desktop client for your computer.

Step 3:

Your Zoom Desktop client will download. You will then need to install the program by clicking the "open" or "go" button.

Step 4:

Once you have downloaded this you can join the meeting. You may need to click on this meeting link again. <https://zoom.us/j/947528456>

The steps are similar when using your mobile device, or iPad. Once you clicked on the meeting URL <https://zoom.us/j/947528456> follow the instructions to install the "ZOOM Cloud Meeting" app.

FAQ

Q: Will I have to go through these steps with every meeting?

A: No, this is just the initial set up. For future meetings simply click on the provided Zoom meeting link.

Q: Can I join the meeting any other way?

A: Yes, you can go to [Zoom.com](https://zoom.com) and click on the "JOIN A MEETING" tab. Add the Meeting ID: 947 528 456 and you are good to go. Note, if you did not already download the ZOOM program (steps 2-4) your system will ask you to do so.

Q: Will this cost me something?


A: No, this is free

Q: Is ZOOM save?

A: Yes, this program will not harm your computer. Safety is a priority. ZOOM implements both Secure Socket Layer (SSL) encryption and AES 256-bits encryption. ZOOM features role-based access control and admin feature controls.
Translation: THIS IS USED BY MANY UNIVERSITIES AND LARGE ORGANIZATIONS so nothing to worry about.

Q: Can I already go through these steps?

A: Yes, this is probably a good idea familiarize yourself with the system so you won't miss any of Helmut's and Peggy's presentation. Jodi already created a meeting. If you join right now you will see the following note.



This means you are good to go.

Q: Can I join the meeting before 7:30 AM?

A: Yes, but you will see the notice above. You can stand by until Jodi, who is the administrator, clicks the GO LIVE button. (I like to think of this as her opening the secret door).

Q: What if I am joining late?

A: Not a problem with the system, however you might have to deal our Sergeant-at-Arms, Dan Westra.

This is like magic.... just easier - you'll see!

Is there anything that can go wrong? Yup, but you will see in a week or two we will all be experts at this online club meeting or webinar adventure!
