So here are the steps to join the meeting:

Step 1:

Click on this link: <https://us04web.zoom.us/j/468395407>

Step 2:

Simply follow the prompts to download the correct Zoom desktop client for your computer.

Step 3:

Your Zoom Desktop client will download. You will then need to install the program by clicking the "open" or "go" button.

Step 4:

Once you have downloaded this you can join the meeting. You may need to click on this meeting link again. <https://us04web.zoom.us/j/468395407>

If you joined last weeks meeting all you need to do is click on the link and it will automatically launch ZOOM. See you there...

"Rotary Day at the Jaguars"...

Resulting from our club participation in the "Rotary Day at the Jaguars" last December.

Our club has been credited with a donation of \$1,125 toward the Polio Plus Campaign of the Rotary Foundation. Most know it as poliovirus. The virus is spread person to person, typically through contaminated water. It can attack the nervous system, and in some instances, lead to paralysis. Since Rotary began its involvement in eradicating Polio worldwide in 1988 the incidence of new cases has been reduced by 99.9%.



Today, only three countries exist where the eradication of Polio has not been completed: Afghanistan, Pakistan, and Nigeria, but even Nigeria has not reported an new case in the past two years. We are currently seeing how small our world has become as we watch the spread of the Corona Virus. Each of us has now had a hand in helping to complete the task and being able to state forever, "I was part of Rotary and helped to 'End Polio Now'" Thank You!
