This week the number is up to 34 families, primarily because the delivery of RX meals has been included. RX meals are shelf stable items that are low sodium, low sugar and are geared for people who have heart issues or diabetes.

We have quite a special day coming up for us on May 27th when a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket will blast off at 4:33PM carrying Bob Behnken and Doug Hurley to the International Space Station for a visit. They plan to return after a few weeks to demonstrate SpaceX's readiness to provide production missions.

This will be the first USA based manned space launch since the final Space Shuttle Flight on July 8, 2011. Do not miss this. You can watch live on SpaceX.com. For sure, there will be several live feeds on YouTube as well. Coverage will likely start 3-4 hours ahead of launch. If all goes to plan, we will see the Falcon 9 rocket land successfully on a barge floating in the Atlantic as well. The name of the barge is, Of Course I Still Love You.

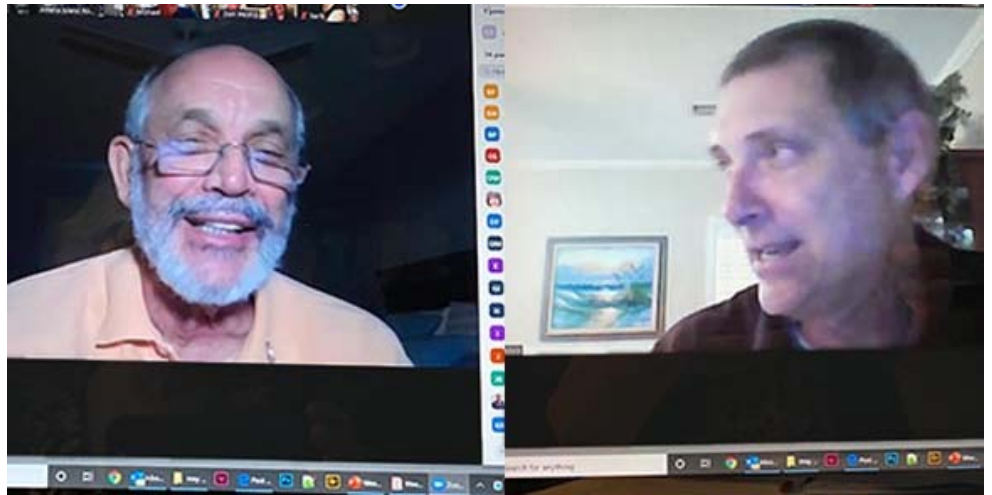
