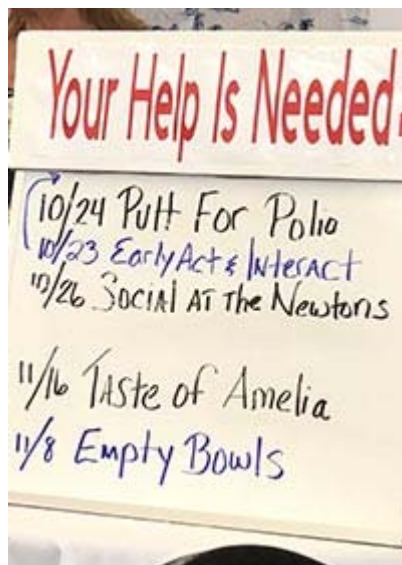

A visit by the Hospital President of Baptist Medical Center Nassau

[Ed Hubel, FACHE](#), who was named president for [Baptist Medical Center Nassau](#) in December of 2016 stopped by inform us about the happenings at the hospital. He noted that hospitals are scary places for patients and families. He continued to tell the story of a 93 old man who had brain surgery. It turns out he also had colon cancer and the attending physician told him that he needed all kinds of tests. The old man and his family were overwhelmed. This was Ed's father. Another story was about an 82-year-old female. On her 82nd birthday she suffered a stroke. Doctors put a lot of pressure on the family by insisting to make important decisions right away. During this confusing and stressful time decisions were made, and Anna survived. She was Ed's mother. The third story was about a baby that was born with a damaged skull. It was a tough decision, but the parents decided to go ahead, and brain surgery was performed on the 8-week-old kid. Ed held up a photo with a smiling kid noting that this was his grandson, who very active today.
