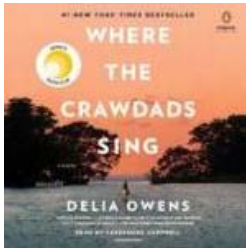


The District Conference on Saturday was inspirational, followed by a special evening program Rotary Night at the Oscars. As you see below, well attended by our Club members and spouses!
