Upon returning to Florida in 2009, Michael held several positions within Florida's legislative process, including 2012-14, Michael served as Deputy Communication Director for the Florida House of Representatives Majority Office (2012-14) and from 2014-2016 as Communications Director for House Speaker Steve Crisafulli. Most recently, Michael served as Director of Media Relations for CoreMessage Public Relations in Tallahassee.

Michael sits of the Florida Film & Entertainment Advisory Council, and serves as the Chairman of the Pastoral Council for the Co-Cathedral of St. Thomas More. Michael lives in Tallahassee with his wife and family.

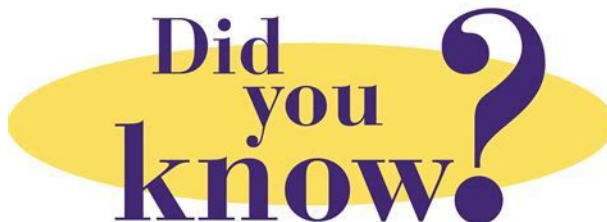
