This Tuesday night, September 7, will be the biggest meal delivery yet in our "Feed the Frontline" effort and we want your help in getting it done!

We are feeding approximately 135 hospital workers at Baptist Beaches that night. As a result, our food provider, Pieology, is employing two different store locations to service the need. Club members, Denny Baldwin, will be heading up our effort at the Pieology in Nocatee while Bob Wiltfong will be at the Pieology location at St. Johns Town Center. We encourage all Rotarians (and their friends) to get involved by showing up at either location at 7:15pm. You'll help us load up the food in cars and then, if you choose, join us for the ride to Baptist Beaches Emergency Room entrance for delivery! Both groups (from Nocatee and St. Johns Town Center) should arrive at the hospital around 8pm. After arriving, we will load up the food onto carts and hospital workers will wheel them into the medical center for a free, delicious dinner!

We are happy to report members of the Rotary Clubs of Palm Valley & Ponte Vedra Beach have donated money to "Feed the Frontline," and we expect to see some of their members (along with you) Tuesday night as a show of support. Thank you, Rotarians!

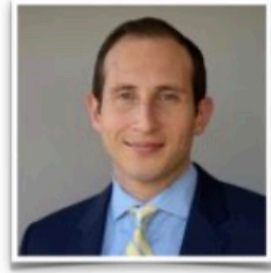
