

After talking with Richard for some time, he found out that he was actually homeless because of the high cost of rent. Deputy Tipton, a profoundly religious man, began an online effort to raise funds for Richard to get a place to stay safely. He did this out of the goodness of his heart, asking family and friends to support. He helped find temporary shelter for Richard, helped provide for medical care, and as of August, raised over \$17,000 to help with Richard's ongoing needs.
