Today's Speaker/Program

The Education Fund provides private sector leadership and support for innovation in public education in Miami-Dade County.

Director of Development Karen DeLeon spoke about the Fund's unique programs. Debi La Belle, a trained chef, is program manager for the Fund's Food Forests for Debi La Belle, a trained cnet, is program manager for the Fund's Food Forests for Schools program for seven years. Of 51 elementary schools in the program, 3 are in Homestead: Laura Saunders, Florida City, and Avocado Elementary. The latter two have edible gardens, the former is a true Food Forest with perennial super-foods made for this climate - feeding the cafeteria system and sending bags of harvested crops home with students. Beyond nutrition training, Food Forests provide environmental training, and info about soils, climate, and agriculture. No pesticides or fertilizers are used. Gardens start with a "banana circle" which contains the makings for compost in the middle besides providing tons of bananas. Gardens cost about \$3000 to sustain but can cost \$15,000 to set up. Other Education Fund projets include Smart Path career planing, For the Love of Art curated 'found object' art awards, Student Power teaching action civics, Teacher Care Campaign to gather donated supplies for redistribution, and Tase of Education to highlight the District's culinary & wine programs.
