Today's Speaker/Program

The Everglades Association finally got an Everglades license plate approved by the state; the plate was designed by Rotarians Steven Shelley and Robert Chaplin. It should be available soon for \$50, 50% of which comes back to the Park (10% of this retained by the Association for programs). Executive Director Jim Sutton spoke on projects to fund - hiring seasonal workers removing 36 derelict vessels, helping water quality studies, seagrass restoration, repairing aids to navigation, and working with Bass Pro on lessons like fishing and learning to kayak. Projects in Big Cypress Preserve include python hunting and using swamp buggies. Biscayne National is working on restoration of Elliott Key and on activities for overnight campers. The County paid \$500,000 for a feasibility study on boating tourists from "the worlds largest cruise dock" (to be completed in 2025) down to Biscayne National Park.
