CITY NEWS:

Rotarian & Homestead Mayor Steve Losner reported Council's meeting tonight will consider FPL's request to put a liquified natural gas storage facility on eleven acres in the Park of Commerce. Safety issues appear settled as the facility would not be in the Air Base's accident potential zone. The problem is the loss of land for businesses to promote jobs in the City. The City looks to refinance its electric utility bond for about \$9 million to pay off the old bond and fund a new substation for \$6. Interest is lower and debt service significantly less.
