Today's Speaker/Program

Lt. Colonel Duilia Turner gave a great presentation on her Air Force mission as Chief of Women, Peace and Security (WPS). This is an all-services effort to endorse and support women serving in the military. Lt. Col. Turner is a meteorologist by training - born in NYC, moved to Brazil at age 2, came to the U.S. at 17 to learn English for school and enlisted in the Air Force at 20. She served missions as a combat weather technician in Bosnia and Afghanistan, and was chief meteorologist for Air Force 1 for a term. She explained the strategic concept of interacting with allies on including women in the services. The concepts are participation, safety and access, adapting internally, and leadership and burden sharing. The mother of twin boys, Lt. Col. Turner counsels veterans thru Brothers & Sisters in her spare times, because "Vets got each other's backs" - a good saying for her current mission.
