Canalfest 2021 – Information Sheet

Canalfest is three fun-filled days on the historic Erie Canal at Bellamy Harbor Park. The festival is a family-oriented event with non-stop music and entertainment, photo/art contest, fishing derby, ski show and many more activities. Please consider joining us as a vendor or club in order to promote your goods or organization!

DATES BOOTH SET-UP: 12PM-4:30PM, August 6th

FESTIVAL DATES: August 6th: 5PM-10PM, August 7th: 12PM-10PM, August 8th: 12PM-5PM

BOOTH & COST INFORMATION:

Canalfest has two different types of booth space available: vendors and not-for-profits.

- 1.) **Vendors/Crafters** – Merchants wanting to sell or advertise goods or services. The cost is \$125 per 10'x10' space. If you require more than one space, each additional space will be \$100. All spaces are outdoors.
- 2.) **Club/Not-for-Profit** - You will receive one space at no charge if approved. **You cannot sell merchandise or hold raffles at this level.** Please apply for a vendor space if you wish to sell merchandise or advertise payment based services.

LOCATION: Bellamy Harbor Park - Rome, NY 13440

PARKING: There is vendor parking that is set aside for our attendees behind the festival. No parking passes are needed.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. **Things to bring:** tent(s), tables and chairs, lights, 100-foot extension cord to reach the available electricity and power strip / surge protector. We also recommend bringing duct tape to tape your extension cords to the walkways in a safe manner.
2. **Security:** There will be a security person on site from 10PM-7AM on Friday and Saturday night. Crafters are welcome to leave their wares in the tent overnight with a light on. Leaving items will be at your own risk.
3. **No applications for face painting will be accepted.** There is a separate area for this already at the Festival. Realistic looking toy guns are also not allowed. Please consult us if you have any questions.
4. **We will accept food vendor applications ONLY IF you have a copy of applicable health permit(s) included with your application and what you are selling is not already being sold by another vendor.**
5. Your items must be kept and displayed in the 10'x10' space allocated to you.
6. Except in emergency situations, vendors are expected to stay until closing time each day.
7. You are not permitted to have your car on the park grounds during festival hours for safety concerns. During setup and after the festival closes you may bring your car onto the grounds to load and unload. Otherwise we do have volunteers/Rotary members who are willing to help you carry items to and from the parking lot.
8. Unless you were a previous vendor or have special needs, most spaces are given out on a first come, first served basis. Please arrive early during setup time to avoid traffic congestion.
