Charles is from Lukaya, Uganda, which is a developing town. He is the mayor there and also the Governor Elect. Charles discussed the need for a maternity ward in the area. As such, these men are putting together a grant for this issue. They currently have only two (2) delivery beds in this area and need to expand and improve this. The next medical center is 40 minutes away and a private enterprise, which is expensive for members of the community. By expanding the medical area, this will attract a doctor to come there, which would also be of great benefit to the area. The clinic will also become a training facility as well. This project will cost roughly \$100,000 and Charles's club is trying to raise \$10,000 to contribute to this project. The club also committed themselves to getting two (2) apartments for midwives so that mothers can deliver at night due to the lack of night services.

Let's Cook!

This week's recipe is brought to you by Erica Sabatini. Since it is officially fall and there are lots of sporting events going on, I thought you might enjoy this at your next tailgate or Sunday Funday Football event.

Italian Beef Sandwiches

Serves 10 sandwiches

Special Equipment

Crockpot

Ingredients

4 lbs boneless beef chuck pot roast

2 tsp salt

1 tsp pepper

1 tsp garlic powder

2 tsp Italian seasoning

15 oz tomato sauce

2 green bell peppers (sliced)

2 yellow onions (sliced)

12 oz jar slice pepperoncini

I recommend having extra to put on sandwiches at the end

10 crusty sandwich rolls (split and toasted)

10 slices of Provolone cheese

Instructions

1. Spray the insert of a 6 or 7 quart slow cooker with cooking spray.
2. Drain the pepperoncini reserving about 3 tablespoons of the liquid
3. Combine the salt, pepper, garlic powder, and Italian seasoning in a small bowl.
4. Trim the fat from the roast and season each side with about 1/3 of the seasoning mix.
5. Place the roast in the slow cooker.
6. Pour the tomato sauce over the roast
7. Top with green bell peppers, onions, and pepperoncini.
8. Sprinkle the remaining 1/3 of the seasoning on top as well as the reserved pepperoncini liquid.
9. Place the lid on and cook on low for 10 to 12 hours or high for 5 to 6 hours.
10. Use two forks to shred the meat. (it should just fall apart)
11. Use a pair of tongs or a slotted spoon to place the beef, onions, and peppers on a roll, top with cheese, extra pepperoncini and toast until cheese melts.
12. Enjoy!
