Let�s Cook!

Buffalo Chicken Stuffed Peppers

Serves 6

Ingredients

- 3 Bell peppers, halved and seeds removed
- 3 Cups cooked shredded chicken
- 1/4 Cup Butter (can substitute ghee)
- 1/2 Cup hot sauce
- 2 Tbsp. soy sauce (can substitute coconut aminos)



1/2 Tsp. cayenne pepper

1/2 Tsp. paprika

1 Cup shredded mozzarella (optional)

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375F. Place the bell pepper halves in a 9x13 inch baking dish. Arrange so that the cut side is up. Fill the bottom of the dish with a small amount of water just enough to cover the bottom
- 2. In a medium skillet over medium heat, stir together the butter, hot sauce, soy sauce, cayenne pepper, and paprika. Remove from heat once the butter is melted.
- 3. Add the shredded chicken an stir until it is coated with the sauce.
- 4. Divide the buffalo chicken between the bell pepper halves. Bake he peppers for 30 minutes. Remove from the oven then top with the mozzarella cheese and bake for another 5 minutes, or until the cheese is melted and peppers are tender. Remove from the oven and top with any additional toppings that your heart desires.
