He is currently Professor of Pediatrics and directs the Adolescent and Young Adult Clinic at ETSU in which over 1500 youth and young adults from all over NE Tennessee receive medical and transition services. His clinic provides a comprehensive primary care for youth with chronic conditions as well as physical and intellectual disabilities and helps coordinate their health care through late adolescence and early adulthood, as they transition from the pediatric system of care to the adult system of care. He is also Director of Global Health Education for the Quillen College of Medicine and has been active in global health work for over 40 years, primarily serving in Ecuador.
