Glenn Rosenoff: Current Projects and Business for the Town of Jonesborough

Glenn Rosenoff was born in Montreal, Quebec, Canada, on March 6, 1969. He graduated from a 2-year program at Vanier College in Montreal with a ♦College Education Diploma♦ and concentration in Political Science. He graduated ETSU in 1992 where he earned his B.S. in Criminal Justice, and earned his Master♦s in City Management in 1995. In 2000, he started work for the State of Tennessee in the Local Planning Assistance Office at their field office in downtown Johnson City as a Community Planner. This office was instrumental in offering professional planning services to a 10-county region whereby communities were unable to afford professional planning staff of their own. Glenn spent nearly 5 years as the Regional Director and in 2011, the state dissolved the statewide program of services, which positioned Glenn to be hired by the First Tennessee Development District to lead their newly formed planning program. He spent 2 years as their director until he was hired by the town of Erwin in 2013 as their Town Recorder/Town Administrator where he would continue to lead

the town for the next 6+ years. In May of 2020, Glenn was hired by the oldest town in Tennessee, Town of Jonesborough, to become their new Town Administrator after Bob Browning had announced his retirement. Glenn moved to the Jonesborough Historic District and is enjoying the fruits of living, working, and playing in Jonesborough. Glenn is a member of the Tennessee City Management Association, and serves on many community boards within Jonesborough. Glenn is married to his wife of 25 years, Lori Kinch Rosenoff, (even after a major remodeling) and is the father of one son, Riley Rosenoff, and two grandchildren.
