Offsite Meeting at Four Oaks Day Services and Training Center June 25, 2021

With over a decade of experience managing homeless programs and shelters, Quincy White offers a unique blend of leadership, vision and knowledge. He has served as the Executive Director of Four Oaks Day Service and Training Center since early 2020, where he has grown the reach of the day center in the community and fostered positive engagement with homeless citizens through his mission of creating a safe haven for the homeless that can lead them to become more independent and self-sufficient. Through his leadership, Four Oaks has grown in size and scope. Some of Quincy's significant contributions include creating a monthly hiring event, expansion of medical services, leading the city of Newport News's homeless initiative during the COVID-19 Pandemic, creating a free storage program, partnering with Newport News YouthBuild, as well as starting an AA and NA support groups,

Quincy has been with Four Oaks Day center since late 2019 serving as an interim director with Volunteers of America. Amongst his, other significant contributions are creating the Emergency Lodging program during the height of the pandemic to provide shelter to the homeless. During the pandemic, the City of Newport News housed over a 100 homeless citizens in hotels as an emergency lodging program. Four Oaks provided daily food delivery and wrap around services to include case management and connection to employment opportunities in hopes of bridging citizens to housing.

Quincy has also held executive leadership roles with Volunteers of America Chesapeake and the Carolina as the Director of Homeless Services of the Residential Program Center (RPC) as well as the Shelter Director of Stepping Stones Family Shelter. Quincy has also founded his own nonprofit; Mercy Movers (a nonprofit moving company). In hopes of assisting homeless individuals and families with free moving services.

Quincy has received his Bachelors of Science from Lynchburg College. As well as receiving Nonprofit of the year honors from the Rockville (MD) Chamber of Commerce and the Nonprofit Partner of the Year from the Montgomery (MD) Coalition of the Homeless.
