Scholarships

No one should have to turn down the opportunity to become a Captain due to financial hardships. Christopher Newport recognizes the importance of scholarships and impacts the lives of over 750 students each academic year. Raising funds for scholarships is an ongoing process and the university's highest priority.

What are the different types of scholarships?

Endowed scholarships are permanent and awarded year-after-year. Contributions to an endowed scholarship are invested to produce income, and an annual award is made to a student(s). The contributions are not touched, so the endowment is everlasting.

An **annual scholarship** may be awarded only as long as you choose to contribute to the fund. We recommend a four year commitment, so that a student may be eligible to receive the scholarship throughout her/his time at Christopher Newport.

Endowed and annual scholarships together allows an annual award to be given while the endowed scholarship grows. The two scholarships can be created with a single gift or over a period of up to five years.

We are partnering with The Tri Cities Chili Peppers Baseball team for a Rotary Night fundraiser on June 24, 2021. Game Time will be 7:00pm and they will be playing the Peninsula Pilots from Hampton. The team plays at Shepherd Stadium located at 901 Meridian Ave, Colonial Heights, VA 23834

Each ticket purchased to the game will have \$4 donated to the End Polio Now fund. This will be matched by the Gates foundation 2 to 1 which will ultimately drive \$12 per ticket to the EPN campaign.
