## Speaker: Mark W. Luckenbach May 28, 2021

**Mark Luckenbach** is a Professor of Marine Science and Associate Dean of Research & Advisory Service at the Virginia Institute of Marine Science (VIMS). As Associate Dean, he provides oversight and strategic leadership of the research enterprise and state-mandated advisory programs at VIMS. He also serves as a co-director for the Commonwealth Center for Recurrent Flooding Resiliency, a collaboration between VIMS, the Virginia Coastal Policy Center at the William & Mary Law School, and Old Dominion University that provides coordinated university-based assistance for addressing coastal and inland flooding resilience and adaptation.

Since joining the faculty at William & Mary's Virginia Institute of Marine Science in 1985, Luckenbach has conducted research on a wide range of topics in estuarine and coastal ecology in the U.S. and Asia, including restoration ecology of oyster reefs and seagrass meadows, shellfish aquaculture, invasive species, and land-use practices and water quality.
