Daniel Baxter is the Business Recycling and Outreach Coordinator for the City of Newport News, Virginia. In this capacity he is an integral part of the City of Newport News Business Support Team which includes the Department of Economic Development, Parks and Tourism and Public Works Departments. Dan works in concert with local businesses to develop and improve waste management, recycling and sustainability programs. Among his assignments are the coordination and management residential and city facilities electronics recycling program and recycling program for municipal buildings. Dan also is an instructor for the Hampton Roads Public Works Academy and the Newport News Public Works Academy.

Dan has served for four years as the Chairman of the [www.askhrgreen.org](http://www.askhrgreen.org) Litter Control and Recycling Committee. He has represented the city of Newport News this team for nearly 14 years as the City representative and also as a volunteer He is a member of the Newport News Master Gardeners outreach team, a consortium of Newport News Waterworks, the cooperative extension Service Master gardeners and Public Works to provide workshops on rain barrels and land use conservation

Dan retired from the US Navy in 1995 as an Air Traffic Controller. He coordinated volunteer resources for the Naval Air Station Norfolk and regional events. Dan has been a member of Virginia Beach Clean Community Commission since 1992 when he volunteered to be a Zone Captain for Clean the Bay Day.. Dan has served as Vice Charmian and as Chairman for the commission From January 2000 until March 2019. Since coming on board, Dan has worked hard to help promote and develop the program matrix the program now enjoys. Dan has served on numerous boards and commissions in the region including Clean the Bay Day and the Virginia Beach Council of Civic Organizations where he served as Vice President and President for 6 years. Dan is the Vice President at the Glenwood Community Association and was recently elected as the President for the Virginia Council for Litter Prevention and Recycling (VCLPR).
