She talked about RI President, Holger Knaack, and that his passion is Rotary Youth Exchange. He and his wife have hosted 43 students to date.

She indicated that it takes 3 years to become a District Governor and during her time she became a Flamingo! There were 532 people at the District Assembly in January in San Diego. This is where she met so many other governors from all around.

She made a comment that "Everything we do opens up opportunities for someone somewhere." That is why it is so important for each of us to explore ways that we can make a difference in our community and our lives.
