## CLASSIFICATION TALK SEPTEMBER 29, 2020



Last week we had the opportunity to meet the real Bob Brewer--a man of many hats! Bob grew up in Kentucky in the 40's and has 5 siblings. They lived in a two bedroom home in the 50's and 60's so he has come to appreciate the real meaning of life. He attended Catholic grade and high school and went on to college in Kentucky.

He is currently CAPT AC (USNRet) and Bob shared his travels through his career with us.

He went up the ranks from an ensign in 1967 to lieutenant then captain by time of his residency. Way to go Bob.

He was a boy scout and went on to volunteer in the scouts and his highlight was a scout leader for 5 jamborees.

He did his internship in Oakland California and his plastic surgery training in Bethesda. He became board certified for EVMS and Portsmouth. Once he retired he went into private practice and ended in Depaul in 2012. From there he took a position at the VA in Hampton and will retire for good the end of this year. He has had 50 plus years and is thankful for his health during this time.

He spoke of his most rewarding experience and that was in 1987 on board the ship Mercy which is a hospital ship. He indicated that this ship can hold up to 1200 people and he shares with us the stats of the ship. It was most impressive to see that it looked very much like a hospital that you would visit right here in our community. He shared slides of the generators, officers mess, flight deck, steel beach, enlisted and officers birthing. He recapped how the patients are processed and treated.

One of the missions was to take the ship to the Philippines where they tested the ship and helped with the port visits. They would spend 7-10 days at each port. The different units on the ship were: cardio, eye, head and neck, Ortho, pharmacy, minor surgery and more.

Bob shared some pictures of some of the surgeries he was involved with. It was most impressive to see the end result and having doctors of this caliber is a blessing.

He indicated that he has had a most rewarding career and has fond memories of his experiences.

Bob stated that the greatest advantages in life occur when you give your best effort to others. He compared this to our Rotary Motto--Service Above Self!

Bob is married to his wife Cindy. He joined our club on November 22, 2011, and has been an integral part of our club every since. We thank you for your service to our country and to our club!
