In 1970 he came to the US to Washington DC to live with a cousin. He had \$15.00 US \$'s in his pocket and knew right then that he had to find a job. He mopped floors, cleaned bathrooms to make ends meet for a bit. Then in 1971 he attended University of Columbia and received his bachelors in Biology in 1975. In 1972 he married Janet. They have two children, Kevin and Karen.

In 1975 he got a job selling medical journals with a publishing company. This is when he sparked an interest in medicine. He then went on to Georgetown University of Medicine. In 1979 he spent his residency in the DC area.

In January 1986 he went into cardiology practice in Hampton with Tidewater Heart Specialists.

In 2002 he decided to take leave and go back to Grenada and open a clinic there, the Grenada Heart Center. It was there that he was introduced to Rotary and became a Rotarian.

In August of 2004, a category 5 hurricane hit and 90% of the island was destroyed. He realized at this moment what needed to be done. Rebuilding was at mind and he worked to help distribute supplies to those in need.

His hobbies include sports especially cricket and soccer, traveling and playing the guitar in his church band. He likes movies and his favorite actor is Jack Nicholson.
