BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

The Rotary Club of Churchland held a board meeting at 5:30 p.m. at Cincinnati Chili with President Debra presiding. Those in attendance were Debra, Sandy, Jim, Nancy, David, Terry, Wanda, Bob, Margaret, Raleigh, Saundra, Les, Charles Owens and Kristin.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Nancy, our Treasurer, reviewed the final 2021 numbers and will present on quarterly basis going forward with a recap presented the other two meetings. We ended the year with \$574 net income in the operating account. The balance sheet reflects checking account assets of \$11,655 which is an accumulation over the past several years. The disbursement account showed net income of \$321. The balance sheet showed us with \$7614 in the checking account and \$29,791 in cds for a total of \$38,102 in total equity. The tax returns will reflect these numbers. She then presented the 2021/22 operating and disbursement accounts report. The Treasurer report was approved as presented.

There were no committee reports under Club, Vocational or International. Bob reported under Community Service that he has contacted all chairs on his list and at this point no definite plans under way. Meals on Wheels is on going and he suggested that two people be assigned the 3rd Thursday of each month. He will announce at Tuesday's meeting. Raleigh reported under Youth services that Joe H is heading Interact and Joe F is taking charge of Rotaract. Renae is on board to help out. They will be reaching out to the schools leaders soon.

Under Old Business--the Tides ballgame is scheduled for August 29 and tickets are 14.00 with \$2 going to End Polio Now. This is a good opportunity to bring families, friends and prospective members. Debra said "Each One, Bring One."

Under new business it was announced that there is a Be Vibrant seminar August 7 and club will reimburse you for the registration fee of \$32.00. There is a Largest Rotary Club Meeting ever to be held July 21 at 1 p.m, ET and will be virtual. National night out is August 3 and we will be working to get members together to participate.

August 3 will be a Club Forum.
