This Wednesday (July 10th) the Rotary Club of Prince George County begins meeting at Luca Italian Restaurant, in downtown Prince George, 6411 Courthouse Road. This is only the second change in meeting location in the 23 year history of the club. We first met at the Dockside Restaurant just south of the Benjamin Harrison Bridge. We met there for 12 years. It was a beautiful location, but ultimately, after 12 years, we decided that we needed to be closer to the commercial and governmental centers of Prince George County. It took over a year of research, but there were no restaurants at that time serving breakfast, except for some of the motels. Those facilities were too expensive for our small club and required a minimum guarantee at breakfast meetings. Peg Whipple and Carol Woodward negotiated with Roas's, which though an Italian restaurant, served breakfast because of its Honeybee's predecessor. Our only regret was that it was not in Prince George.
