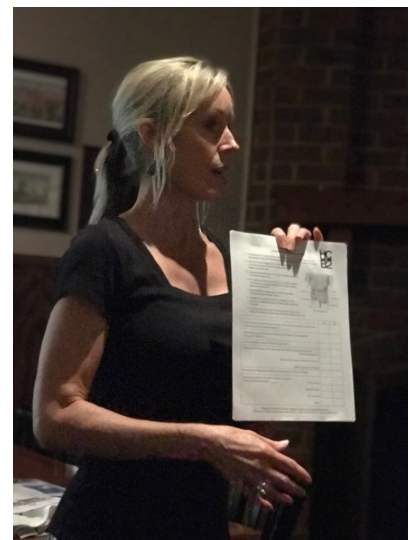
WINE CORKS OF LOVE
