An employee of the library system since 1988, Martha held multiple management positions including Head of Circulation of the Porter library and Branch Manager of three different library locations. She is a past-President and current member of the Virginia Library Association (VLA), as well as a member of both the Public Library Association (PLA) and American Library Association (ALA).

Martha is a 2017 graduate of the Fredericksburg Regional Chamber of Commerce's Leadership Fredericksburg initiative, she is a former member of the Chamber's Network of Enterprising Women Steering Committee and is an active Chamber board member. Martha also serves on the University of Mary Washington's Leadership Colloquium Advisory Board as well as the Rappahannock Goodwill Industries Board of Directors. She is a former member of the North Stafford Rotary Club, having held the positions of Secretary, President-Elect, and President during her membership and remains active in Rotary International.

In 2017, Martha was recognized with the Fredericksburg Regional Chamber of Commerce's Laurie A. Wideman Enterprising Woman's Award and was recently named the recipient of the Patricia Lacey Metzger Distinguished Achievement Award at the University of Mary Washington's 25th annual Women's Leadership Colloquium.
