### April 29th - Stafford Rotary Welcomes Virginia State Delegate Joshua Cole

Joshua was born in Washington, D.C., and grew up in Stafford County, Virginia. He graduated from North Stafford High School and attended Liberty University for three years. He worked for Liberty University and Richmond City Public Schools. He was also a pastor and is the president of the Stafford County NAACP.

Joshua has served as an assistant pastor at the Union Bell Baptist Church and as national director of ecumenical affairs at the Holy Christian Orthodox Church. He has served Stafford County Public Schools Superintendent's Equity, Diversity and Opportunity Committee, the Greater Fredericksburg Area Interfaith Council, as the President of the Stafford County NAACP and participates with numerous other local and community initiatives.



Joshua's background in Virginia's political affairs is rich, dating back to 2005, when he was appointed by the then-speaker, the Honorable William J. Howell, as a Page for the Virginia House of Delegates. That same year he was chosen as the Governor's Page by Governor Mark R. Warner. He returned to the General Assembly again in 2016 as a Staff Assistant to the Clerk of the Virginia State Senate.

After narrowly losing the 2017 House of Delegates election, he came back to handily win the seat in 2019. His committee assignments include Education, Public Safety, Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources.

Ed was born in Chicago, Illinois. He joined the United States Air Force in 1978, before transition to stay at home life in June 1998. In January of 2002 he started work as an airport operations specialist before taking over the role of airport manager in June of 2005.



## FDA Approved Face Masks

Masks are sold in quantities of 25: For every **5 masks sold**, Stone’s will donate a mask to our First Responders, Assisted Living or Nursing Home Facility.
