

This Week's Speaker: Kathleen Steniger from Gwyneth's Gift Foundation



Gwyneth's Gift Foundation, is a non-profit charity, devoted to raising community awareness and education of Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the use of Automated External Defibrillators (AED). They are creating a Culture of Action through their **Foundation Programs:**

🚦 Automated External Defibrillators (AED)

An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is a device that gives an electric shock to the heart. Defibrillation is an essential step in the Chain of Survival and AEDs are the only device that can be used to restart the heart of someone suffering a cardiac arrest. If available, AEDs may be used by members of the public at the scene of a cardiac arrest.

🚦 Training

Communities that have increased out-of-hospital survival rates have done so in part through public awareness campaigns, widespread training in CPR and AED use, as well as the placement of AEDs in public locations. Leading the Nation in 2016 is Seattle, King County, Washington whose out-of-hospital cardiac arrest survival rate is 56%. GGF intends to achieve similar success by offering FREE community-based hands-only CPR training.

🚦 Gwyneth's Gift Scholarship Award

The Gwyneth's Gift Foundation was formed in loving memory and honor of Gwyneth Griffin who is a testament to us all on how to live freely with undeniable optimism and compassion toward others.

🚦 Public Awareness

The Awareness Program focuses on using social media, Foundation created material, free training at community events, advocacy, and public speaking engagements to promote the importance of Hands-Only CPR and the use of an AED. Additionally, we partner with civic groups, local EMS, grassroots organizations, and private business to bring awareness to a bystander's ability to save a life. To spread awareness throughout a community, Gwyneth's Gift Foundation also supports programs such as PulsePoint and HeartSafe Community..

PROPOSING NEW MEMBERS
