## Kim Yeager, Placement Coordinator at the Academies of Loudoun, to Speak

The Rotary Club of Ashburn, VA is pleased to welcome Kim Yeager, Placement Coordinator at the Academies of Loudoun, as our guest speaker this week.

Kim Yeager is the Placement Coordinator at the Academies of Loudoun and has worked for Loudoun County Public Schools since July 2008. Her role is to help students research, identify, and secure learning opportunities beyond the typical classroom setting. This involves working closely with the business community to find experiences such as mentoring, shadowing, internships, apprenticeships and volunteerism all of which the very talented students at the Academies of Loudoun are eagerly seeking.

Since the school opened in August 2018, Ms. Yeager established the fundamental parameters of the Academies of Loudoun Experiential Learning program. She has worked with nearly 400 Academies students on resume writing, job searches, interview prep, and career exploration. She has reached out to hundreds of business to find viable experiences for students. 30 companies visited the Academies of Loudoun to offer jobs, internships, mentoring and volunteer opportunities to Academies students in the 2018-2019 school year, and Ms. Yeager hopes to at least double that number for 2019-2020.

Ms. Yeager holds a Commonwealth of Virginia post-graduate teaching license, a Bachelor's in Communications from George Mason University, a Master's Degree in Education from Virginia Tech and in 2017, she earned a certification in Educational Leadership from the school of Education at George Mason
