Who will be Loudoun County's Commonwealth Attorney?

The Rotary Club of Ashburn, VA welcome Buta Biberaj (pronunciation ♦♦Beu-Tuh Bib-Er-Eye♦♦) as the guest speaker for Thursday, September 5. Biberaj is seeking the office of Commonwealth ♦s Attorney for Loudoun County.

Trial attorney for over 25 years, substitute judge for over 11 years, and guardian ad litem for 23 years. Business owner in Loudoun (Law Practice in Leesburg) since 1993; Loudoun resident since 1996. Part-time prosecutor for Town of Herndon, Virginia. My focus as the Commonwealth ♦s Attorney for Loudoun County will be to create a synergy of resources within to community to prevent crime, provide services to victims, to end the school to prison pipeline, and to provide transparency in prosecutions and sentencing matters.

What is the job description of a Commonwealth Attorney?

The attorney for the Commonwealth and assistant attorney for the Commonwealth shall be a part of the department of law enforcement of the county or city in which he is elected or appointed, and shall have the duties and powers imposed upon him by general law, including the duty of prosecuting all warrants, indictments or informations charging a felony, and he may in his discretion, prosecute Class 1, 2 and 3 misdemeanors, or any other violation, the conviction of which carries a penalty of confinement in jail, or a fine of \$ 500 or more, or both such confinement and fine. He shall enforce all forfeitures, and carry out all duties imposed upon him by ♦ 2.2-3126. He may enforce the provisions of subsection D of ♦ 18.2-268.3.

MESSAGE FROM D7610 GOVERNOR

Tuesday, September 3, 2019

Dear Fellow Rotarians,

As you may know, hurricane Dorian has decimated large swaths of the Bahamas. Rotary Zones 33/34 is ready to assist with the humanitarian work that will take place in the days, weeks, and months to come. I have heard directly from Past President Barry Rassin and things on the ground are not good.

Rotarians in the Southeastern US and our Sister Islands in the Caribbean are already organized, and we have the ability to accept Disaster Relief Contributions NOW! **Attached is the contribution form** which can be used for any form of contribution in general, or specified to a particular area affected by Hurricane Dorian. I have also **attached a list of supplies** that are needed. A Hurricane Dorian Relief Task Force is formed (which I am a part of), and modeled after the Hurricane Florence Task Force in our zones last year. We are keeping our eye on shipping movements to ensure we know which ports to utilize for supply delivery. We are also partnering with Disaster Aid USA and they will be sending a team to the Bahamas to conduct an on-the-ground assessment.

I'm asking each of you to be a part of the Relief Effort NOW! As the District Governor, I am asking you to share this information and the attached documents locally both within Rotary and outside of Rotary as well. You can help help us "Spread the Word". You can also showcase Rotary locally by getting this information out to local media, and share it on your own personal social media posts.

Dorian is currently nearing the mainland on the Florida coast, and no one is sure what path she will take upon landfall and over the next several days. I will keep the district informed of any efforts that are needed once the storm makes landfall in the U.S. So, the time to act is NOW!

100% of ALL MONEY COLLECTED will go to aid. Not all people know that we are a totally voluntary organization, so emphasize this point in your communications.

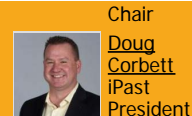

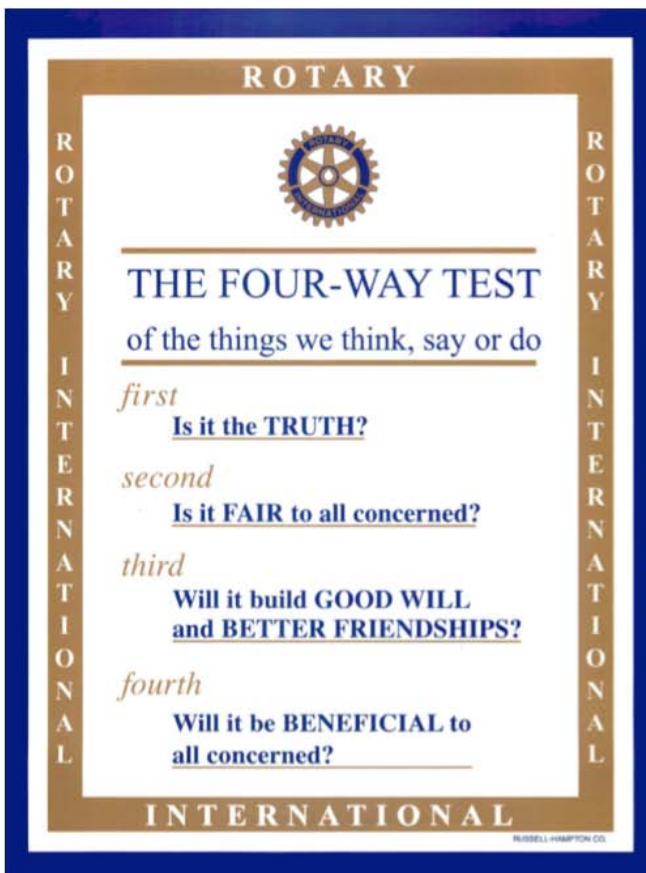
