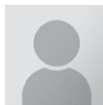

Rotary Foundation Gala November 21, 2021

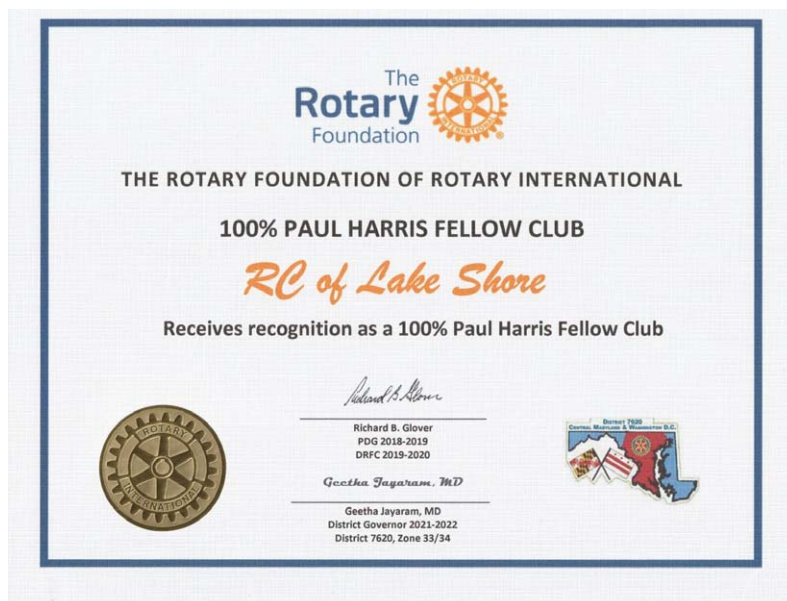

Rotary Foundation Gala - Nov 21, 2021

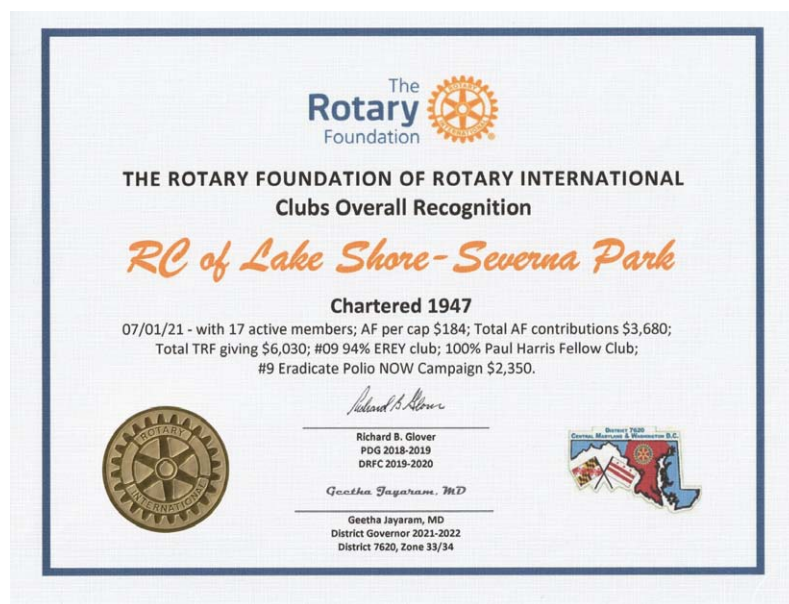
