# What You Missed ...


Last week, our friend and District Rotary Foundation Chair, Rich Graves, spoke to the club about The Rotary Foundation (TRF) and how your contributions are used to benefit others around the world. The mission of TRF is "to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education and alleviation of poverty."

TRF was started in 1928 with \$2400 and now is worth over \$1 billion!! They contribute approximately \$300 million per year around the world to support their mission.

All Rotarians are encouraged to donate at least \$25 per quarter to the Annual Fund. This money is divided into two major portions: 50% comes back to our District and 45% goes to the World Fund. 5% and the interest accrued from all funds is used for administrative costs. Of the 50% that returns to the District, 50% is used for District grants and 50% is used for Global grants. Any club can apply for a District or Global grant, so contributions go directly to helping clubs achieve their goals of helping the community.
